

Celebrate Earth Day with 4-H Camp Wabasso! Make a Pinecone Bird Feeder!

Materials Needed:

- 1 Large Pinecone per Bird Peanut Butter (or Feeder
- 8-inch piece of cotton string (yarn works well!)
- **Vegetable Shortening**)
- Bird Seed
- Spoon

Directions:

- 1. Tie the 8-inch string around the pinecone and then make a loop so you can hang the pine cone feeder on a tree.
- 2. With a spoon, scoop and press the peanut butter (or vegetable shortening) on the pinecone, carefully pushing the peanut butter under the pinecone scales.
- 3. Once covered, roll the pinecone in bird seed.
- 4. Hang the pinecone bird feed on a tree.



Continue Learning: After you have hung up your bird feeder, watch it regularly. Draw pictures of the different types of birds that you see in a nature journal!
